

ALLERTON MAULEVERER WITH HOPPERTON PARISH MEETING

MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING HELD ON SATURDAY 5TH MARCH 2016 AT THE MASONS ARMS

1. **Apologies:** None offered.
2. **Minutes of the Last Meeting:** These were not read out as they had been circulated to all present.
3. **Water Table and Flooding:** The situation was discussed at length. It was requested a letter be addressed to Yorkshire Water and Highways to seek help and guidance and request action re drainage. Harrogate BC has a dedicated person to offer advice.

5. **Strategic Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment:** The local proposed sites were discussed. A request was made to find out at what point a development would create the need to update services and utilities within the village. Harrogate BC has confirmed no such point exists. A consultation will commence in October 2016. At this point individuals and the Parish Meeting can make observations and any objections.
6. **Election of Officers:** A request was made by the Clerk for nominations for any new Officers. No nominations were made and the incumbent Officers offered to stand for a further year. A proposal was put to the meeting that the Incumbents be re-elected which was passed unanimously.

 - ii. Hopperton Street and King Street Triangle and Junction: It was noted cars had regularly been parked blocking both Hopperton Street and King Street at various points. Could residents be reminded not to block access along Hopperton Street or on King Street (Which is used for turning)
 - iii. Common Land: The current rules allow land to be nominated as common and placed on a Register. The Clerk will look into this for the village green and King Street triangle and notify the highways and the owners accordingly
